How to edit and create
your website

Designing your website in five steps

1. Activate the editing mode of your website!
2. Insert and edit your text!
3. Save your page regularly!
4. Insert and edit pictures!
5. Insert sources and additional links!

Here's how to do it! 😊

Step 1:
Click on the hyperlink above your topic picture.

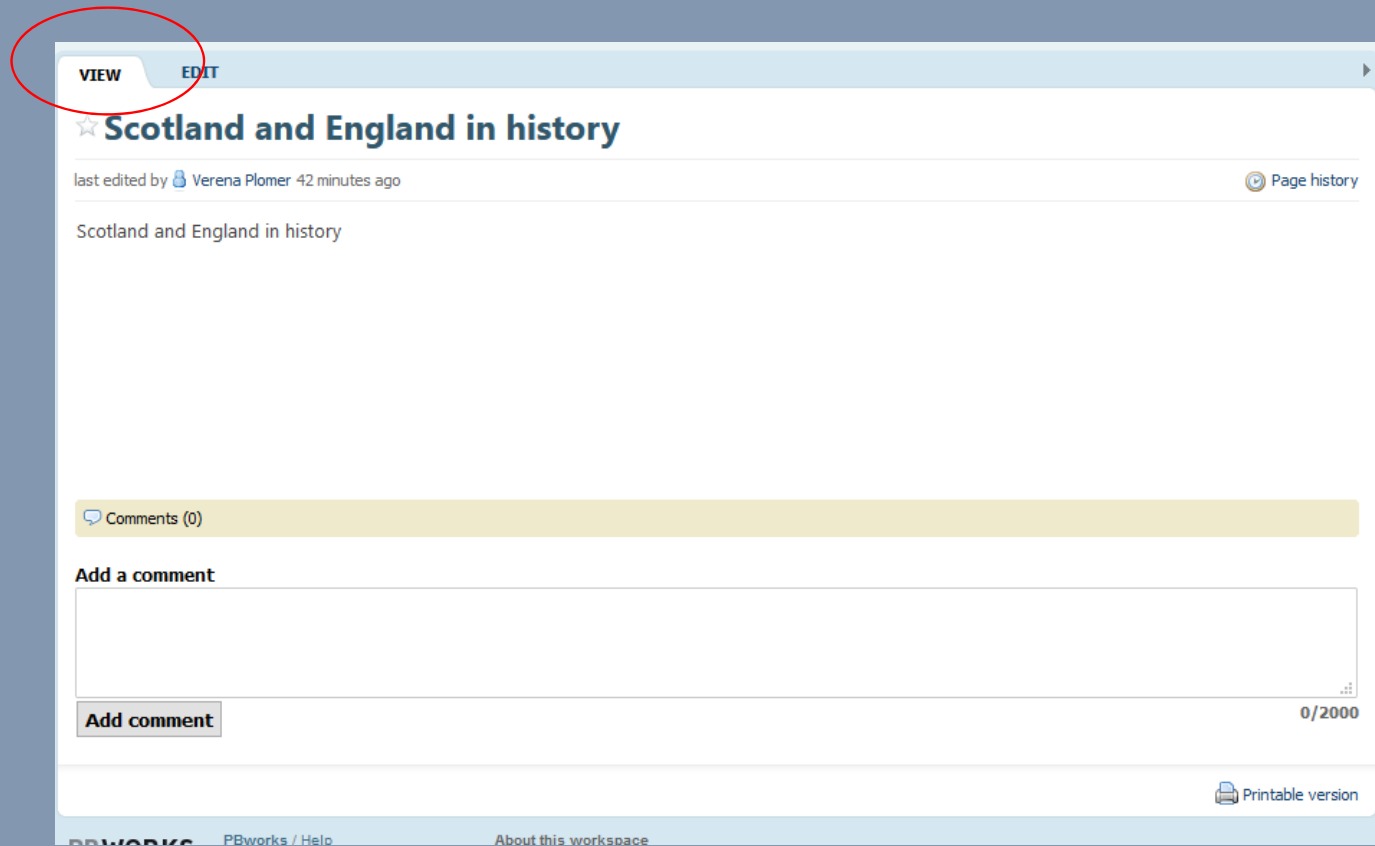
Here's what to do:
Create your own website for your topic.

- Write a short text (~300-500 words) about your topic. Present the most essential details.
- Illustrate your topic with three visuals (pictures, cartoons, statistics, graphs, paintings, ...).
- Provide a good link for a short video / documentary that you liked.
- Indicate all the sources you used.
- You might also add some additional sources that students can use to deepen their knowledge.

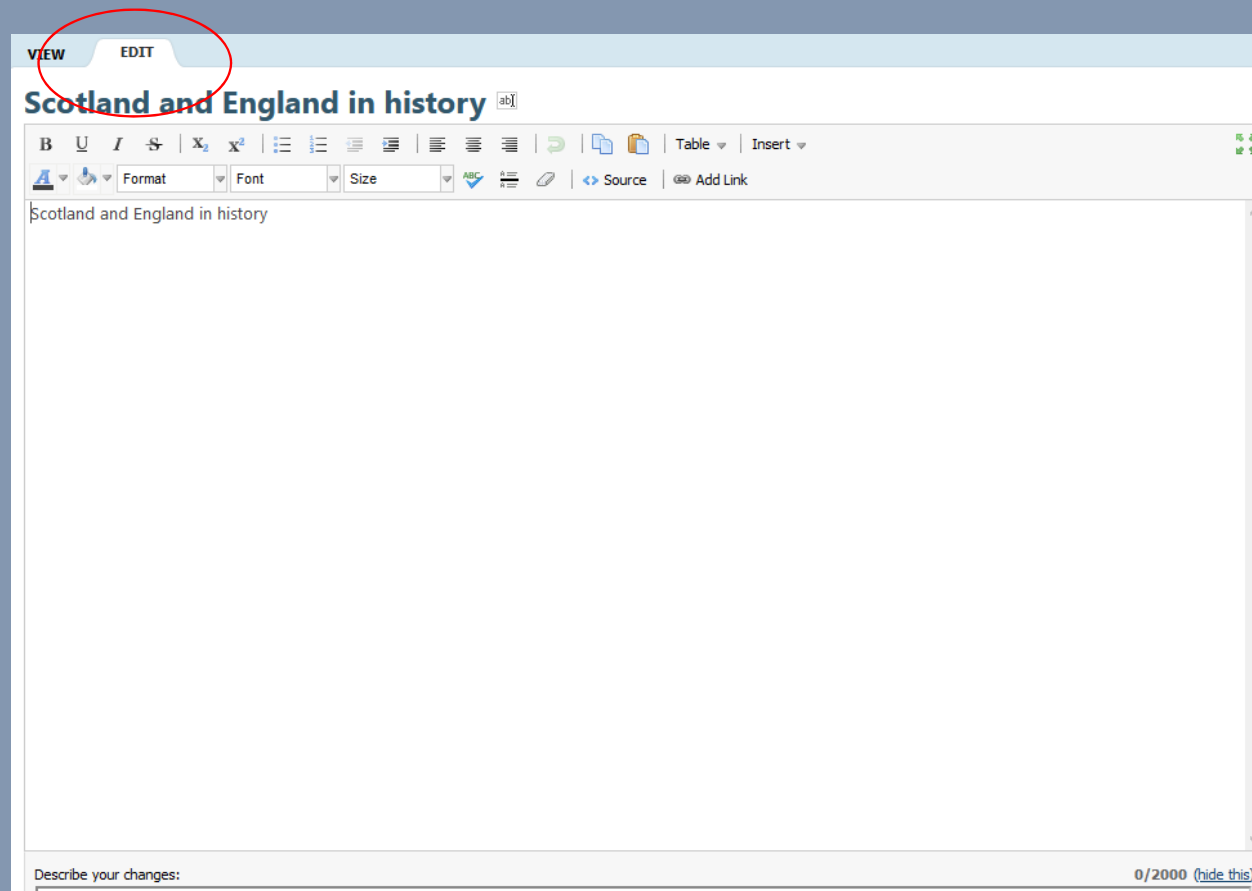

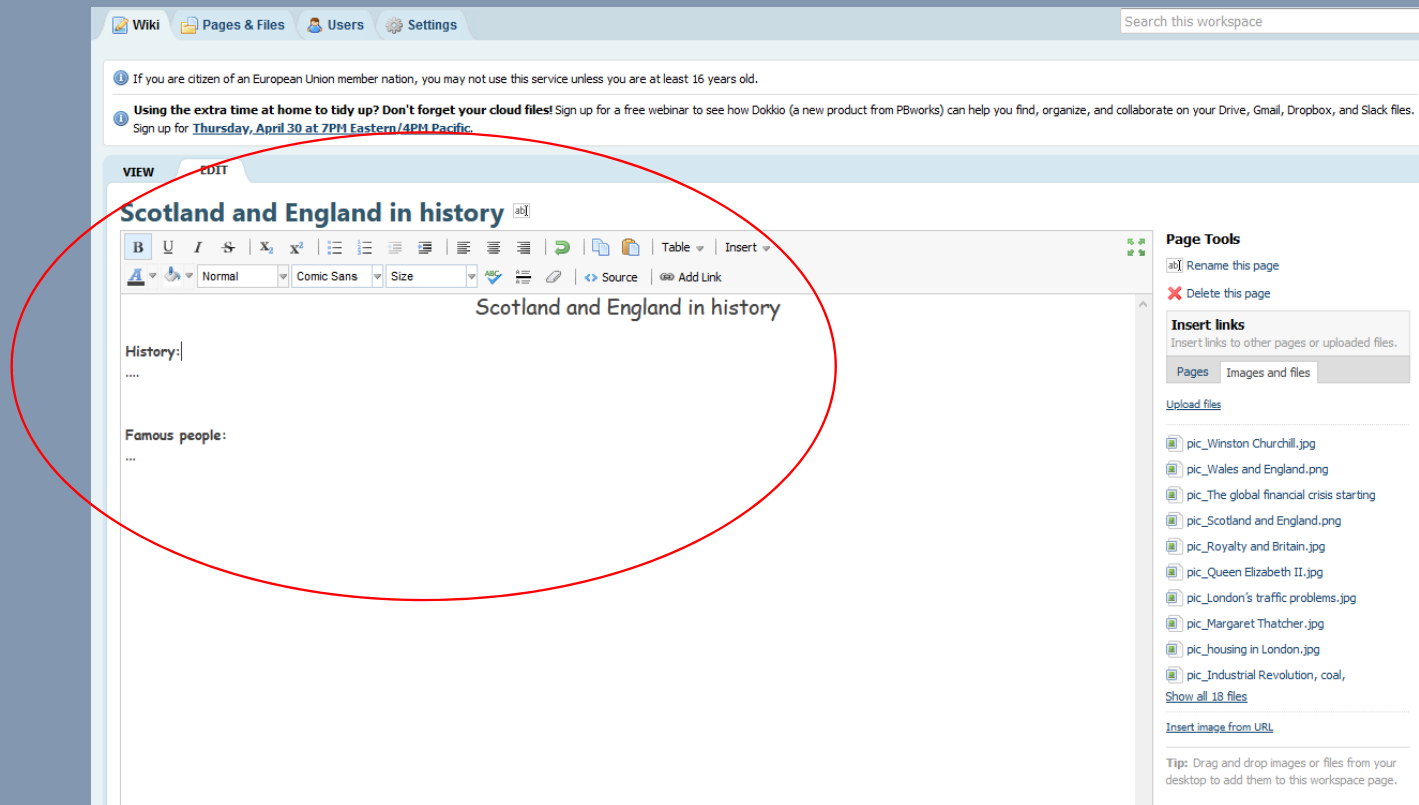

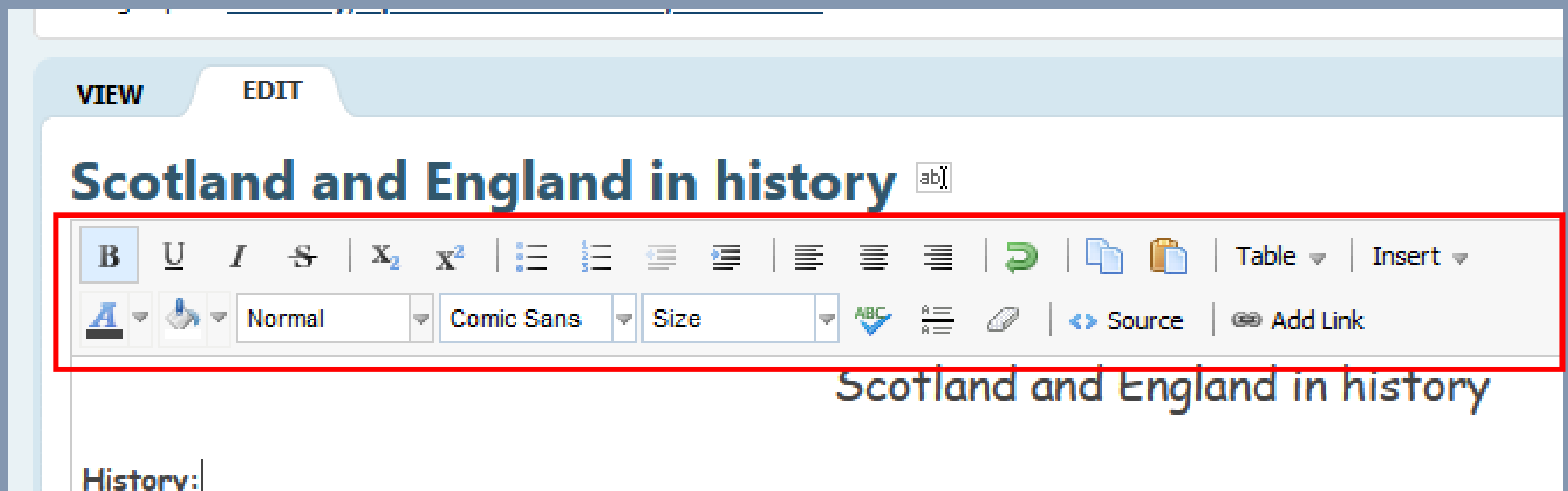
Change to the “EDIT” mode to edit your website.




Step 2: Insert and edit your text and paragraphs.

Step 3: Save your page regularly: Press „Save and continue“ at the bottom of the page.



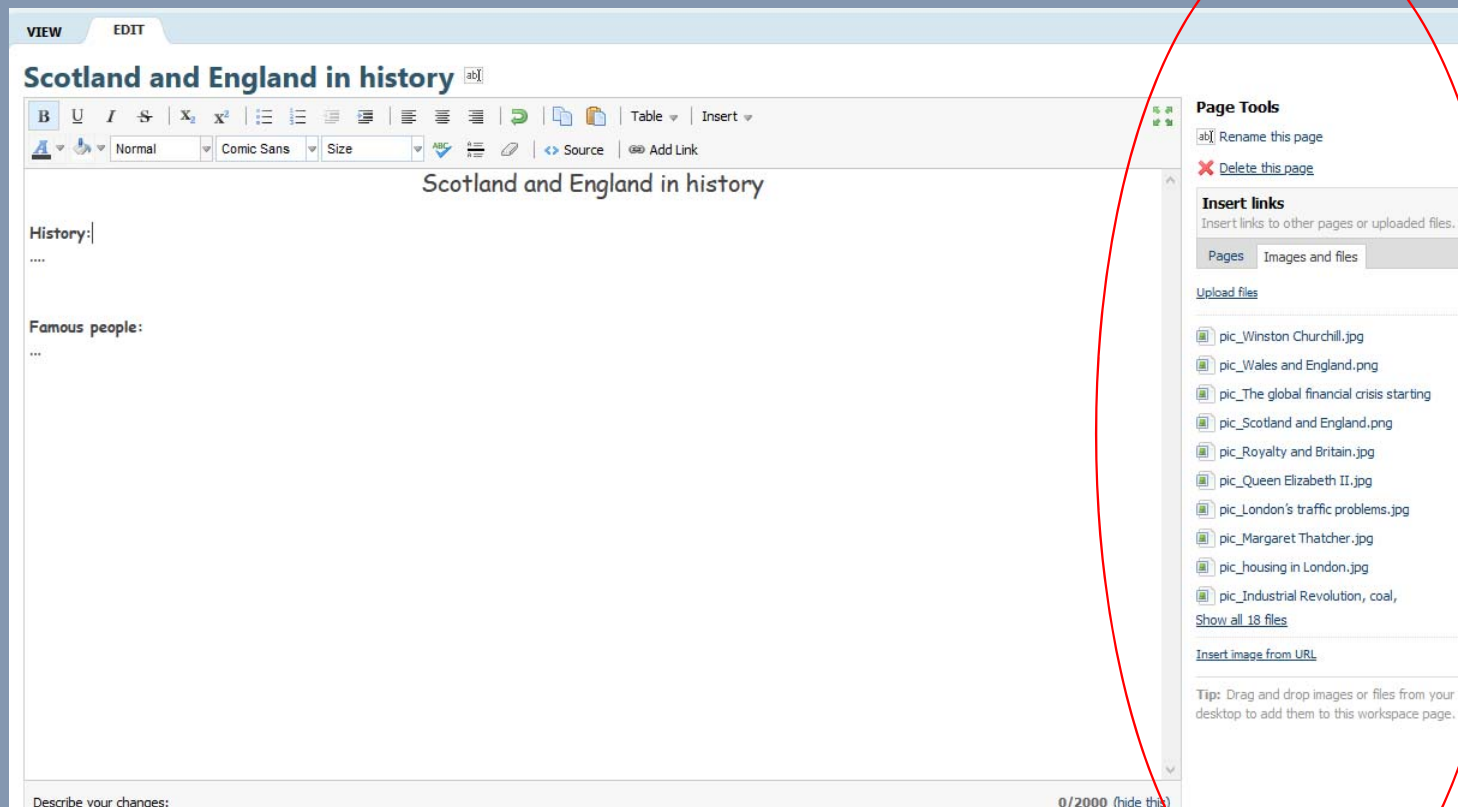

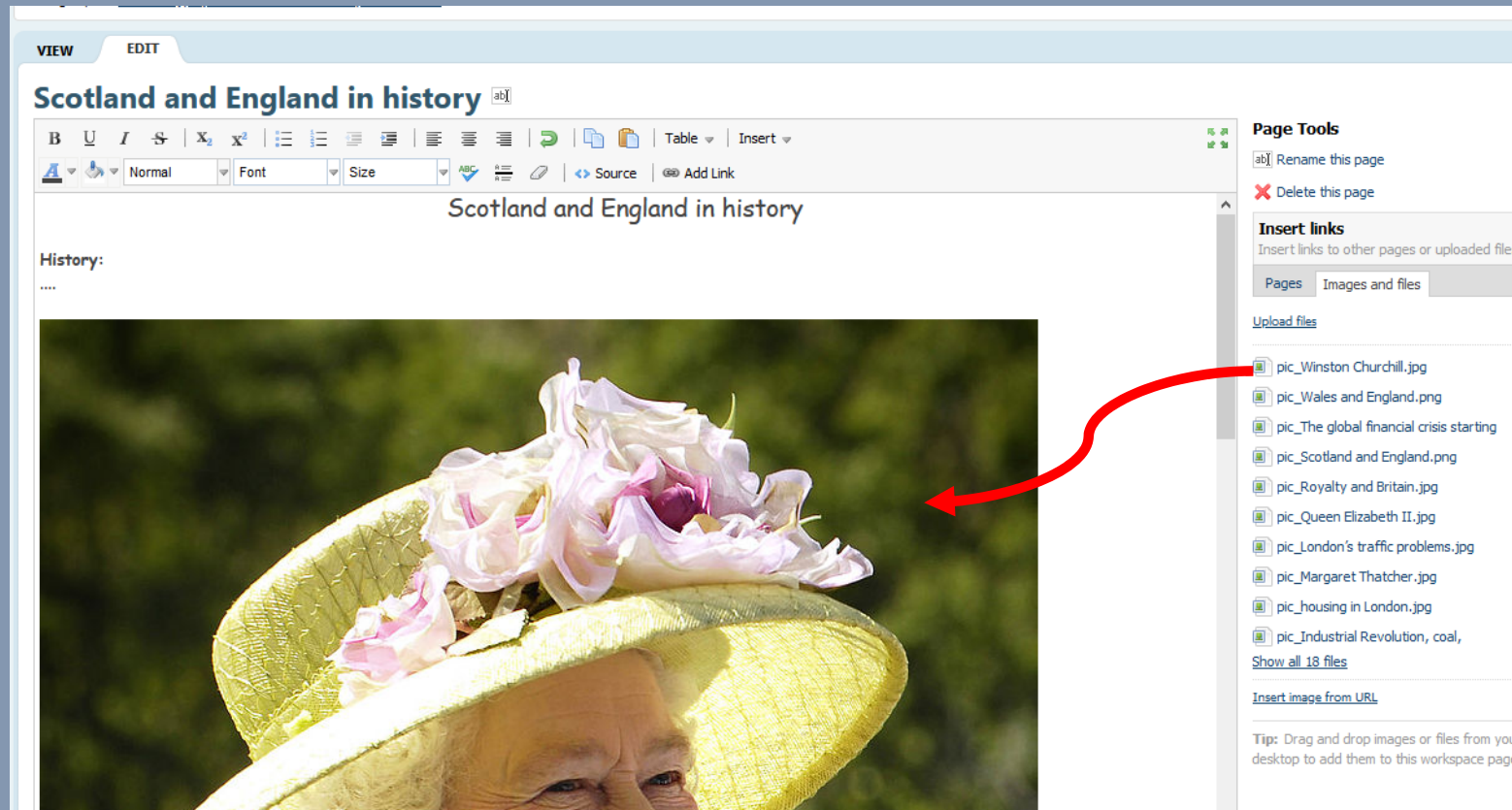

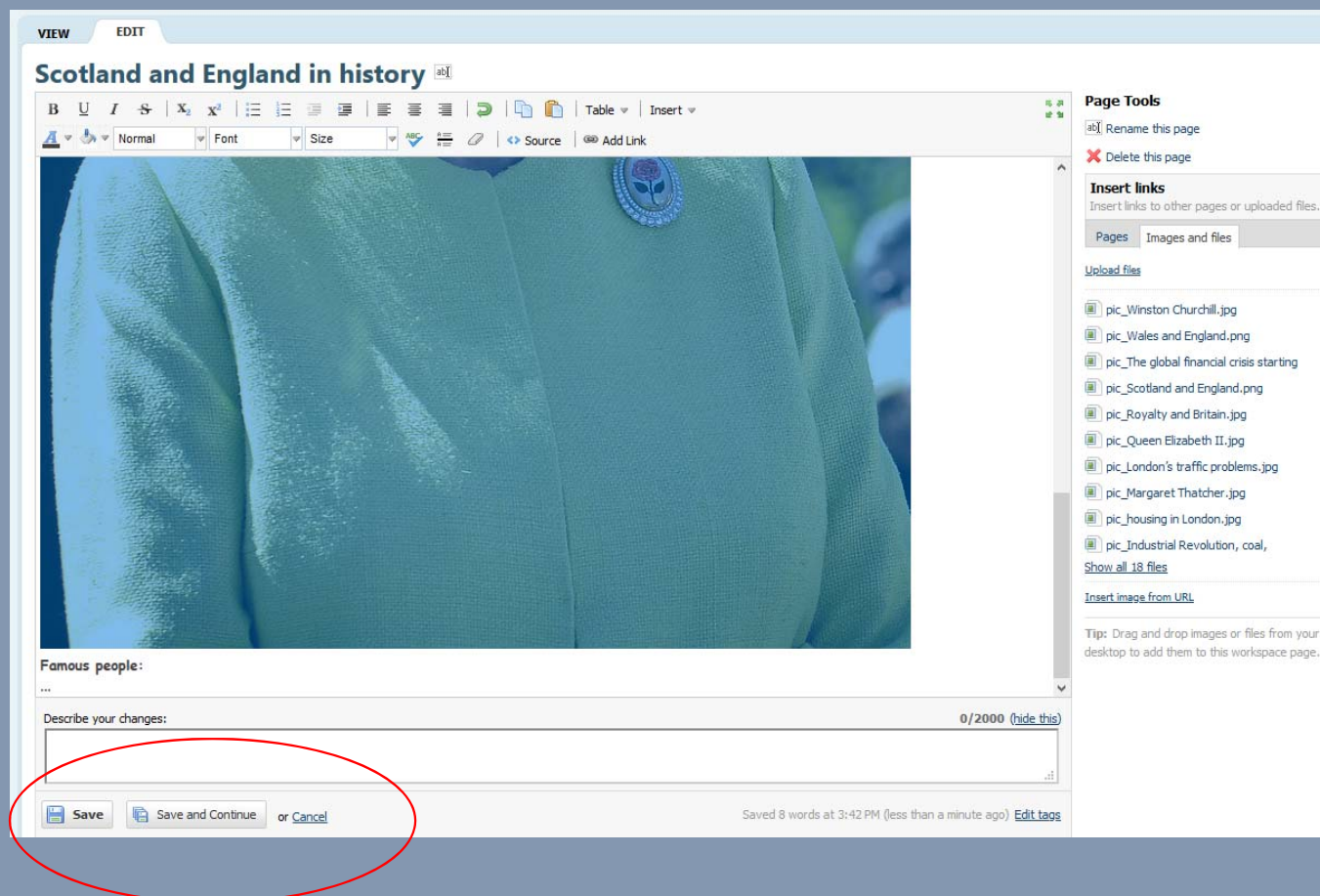
Step 4: Insert pictures.



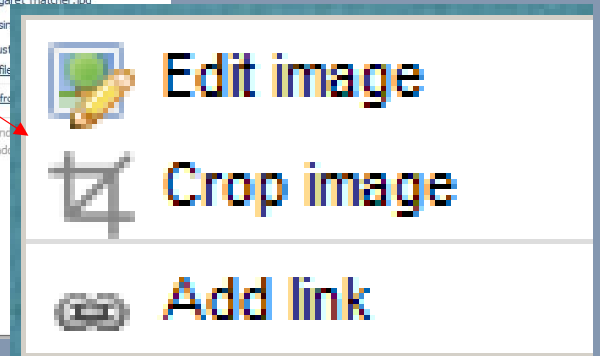
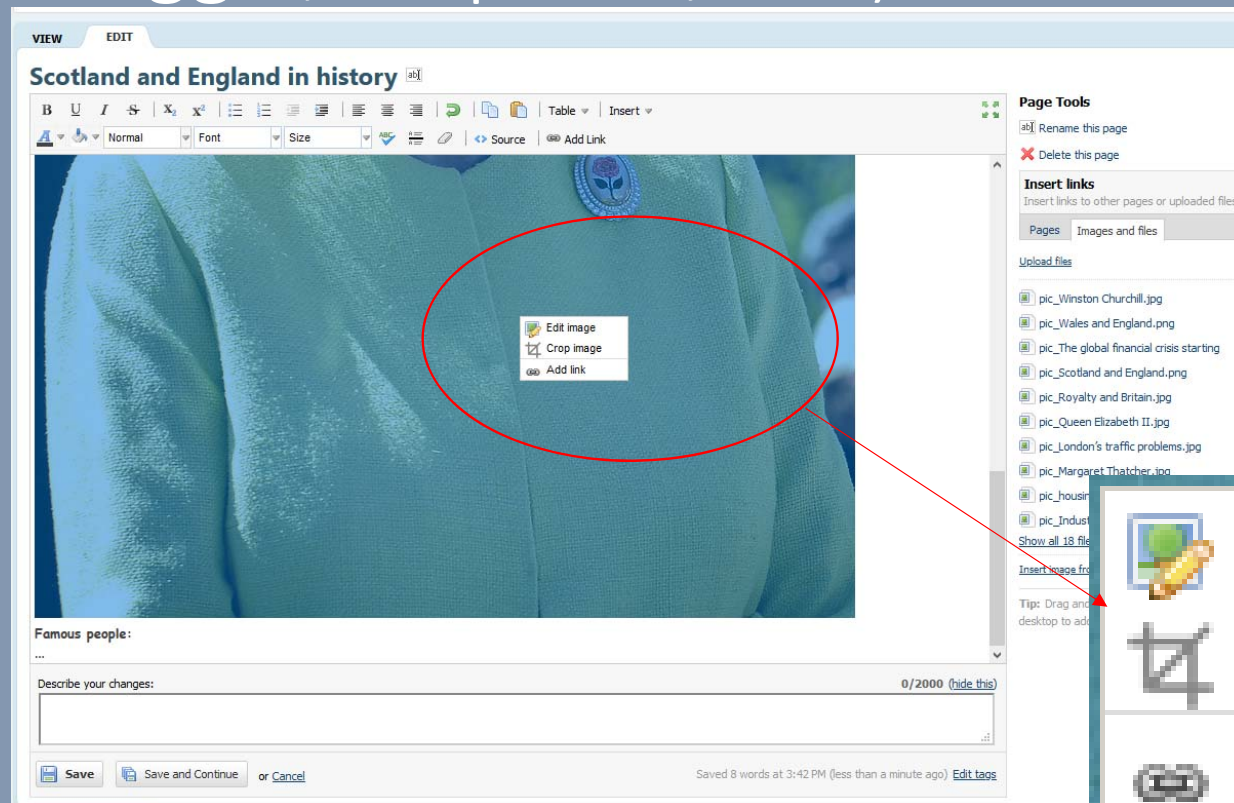
Often your picture appears to big or to small after dropping it on your website.



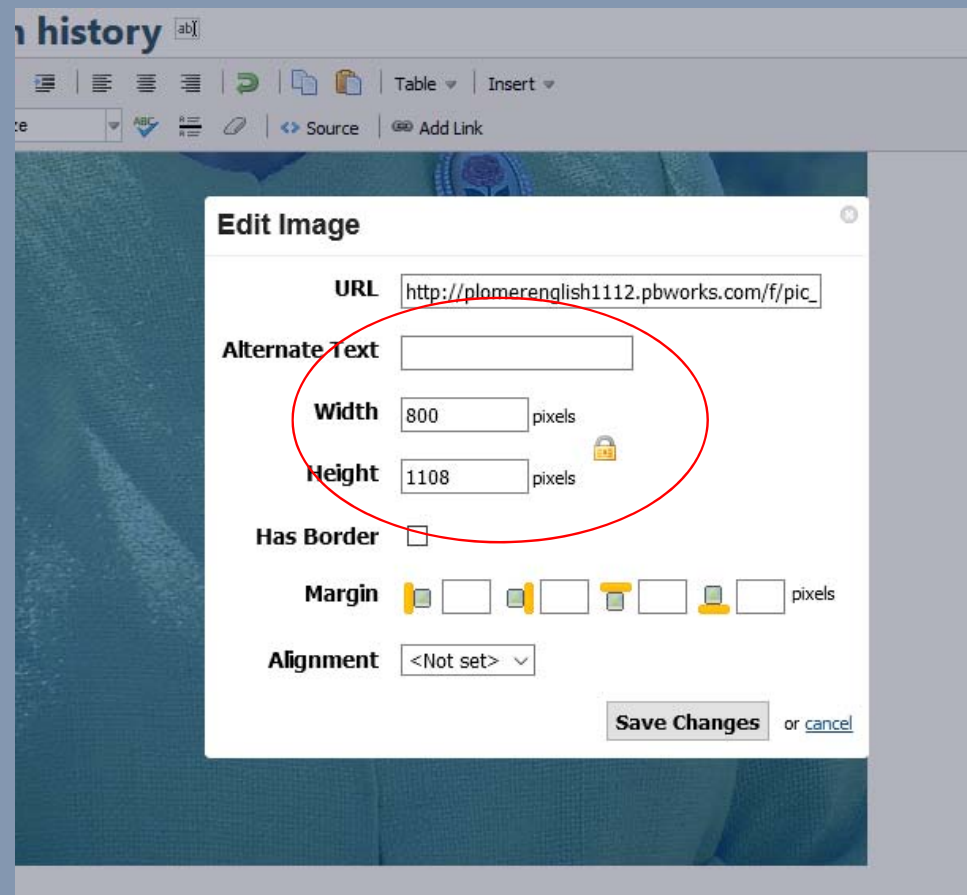
Save your page after inserting the picture – only then, it is possible to edit pictures.



After saving, click on your picture with the right mouse button. Choose edit picture to make it smaller or bigger, crop to it, etc.).



Choose a good size, e.g. 200 pixels width.
Adapt the size of picture to your text.



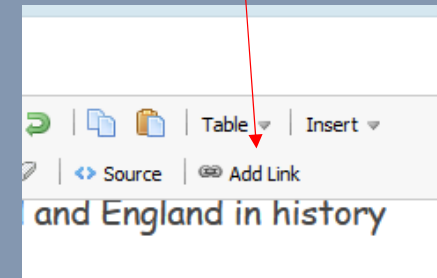
Step 5: Insert sources and additional links.
